The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Mayor Richard Hamit. The clerk called the roll, noting a quorum was present.

The subject of pool manager/supervisor duties and pay scale for manager, assistant manager and guards was discussed at length. It was agreed by consensus that the manager supervisor would do all hiring, scheduling, purchasing, time sheets, and notifications to the schools. It was also agreed the guards would relieve in the bathhouse at the same rate of pay as when they are guarding. Mark Criger made a motion seconded by Dale Fox to set the pay scale as follows:

MANAGER\SUPERVISOR - \$4.75 per hour base pay with an extra
\$.25 per hour for each certificate (max.pay \$5.25 per
hour.

ASSIST. MANAGER - \$4.50 per hour

W.S.I. GUARD - \$4.25 per hour
GUARD - \$4.00

Motion carried.

It was agreed the clerk would place an ad in the local newspaper to run two weeks consecutively. The deadline was set at April 1.

Bruce Smith discussed the subject of whether to hire someone to paint the pool or the city do it with volunteer help. Smith said this is only the third summer since the pool was last painted (\$4,800) and that it had not held up well at all. He said he had checked into the cost of purchasing just the paint and it would cost approximately \$1500. It was agreed by consensus that the city would purchase the paint and would take care of the labor themselves with volunteer help. It was also agreed that Dale Fox would contact the fire department to see if they would contract to use their fans, etc. to help.

Dale Fox made a motion, seconded by Mark Criger to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm.
