**ORDINANCE NO. 13**

**NOTICE OF AMENDMENT  
TO ORDINANCE NO. 12, DA-  
TED DECEMBER 7, 1950.**

Being an amendment by the  
City Council repealing Sections  
1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 12  
dated December 7, 1950, pertain-  
ing to the license fee for marble  
machines, games of chance and  
coin operated music machines in  
the City of Overbrook, Kansas  
and substituting therein Sections  
1 and 2 reading as follows:

Section 1—Any person or per-  
sons, firms or corporations own-  
ing or operating any coin or non-  
coin operated machines constitu-  
ting amusement, entertainment or  
games of chance or skill shall  
first procure a license from the  
city clerk of the City of Over-  
brook.

Section 2—That each and ev-  
ery person, firm or corporation  
shall pay a license fee of \$10.00  
per machine per year. The Over-  
brook Fair Association, carnivals  
and civic organizations operating  
on a temporary basis are exclud-  
ed.

approved by the Mayor this 3rd  
day of January, 1951.
