

ORDINANCE NO. 214

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF MOTORBIKES, BICYCLES, TRICYCLES, SKATEBOARDS, SCOOTERS, ROLLER BLADES OR ROLLER SKATES ON SIDEWALKS RUNNING PARALLEL TO MAPLE STREET WITHIN THE AREA BOUNDED BY SANTA FE TRAIL STREET ON THE NORTH TO SECOND STREET ON THE SOUTH IN OVERBROOK, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERBROOK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride, drive, use or operate a motorbike, bicycle, tricycle, skateboard, scooter, roller blades or roller skates on sidewalks running parallel to Maple Street within the area bounded by Santa Fe Trail Street on the north to Second Street on the south, Overbrook, Kansas.

SECTION 2. For purposes of this ordinance, a bicycle or tricycle includes tricycles or other three wheeled or four wheeled machines, whether operated by human power, electrical or fuel, but does not include vehicles being used in the transportation of physically challenged persons. Any operation of such a vehicle for physically challenged persons shall be done in a manner to not impede, impair or restrict the use of sidewalks by pedestrians.

SECTION 3. Any person convicted, or that enters a plea of guilty, or "no contest" to a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00.

SECTION 4. Any police officer is authorized to seize, or cause to be removed, any motorbike, bicycle, tricycle, skateboard, scooter or similar vehicle being used in violation of the ordinance, and the charge of removal and storage or impoundment of the motorbike, bicycle, tricycle, skateboard, scooter or similar vehicle shall be charged to the owner of said vehicle.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the official city newspaper.
