### ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A  
PORTION OF MARKET STREET IN  
HIGH SCHOOL ADDITION TO OV-  
ERBROOK, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Govern-  
ing Body of the City of Overbrook,  
Kansas:

SECTION ONE: That the South  
15 feet of Market Street between  
the East line of Cedar Street and a  
point 140 feet East thereof be and  
the same is hereby vacated and title  
thereto relinquished to the owner  
of real estate thereto adjacent in  
proportion to the frontage of such  
real estate, subject to and except-  
ing and reserving the right to use  
the same for the location and main-  
tenance of public utility lines and  
said vacation is made subject to  
such use.

SECTION TWO: That this ordi-  
nance shall take effect and be in  
force from and after its passage, ap-  
proval and publication in The Over-  
brook Citizen as provided by law.
