ORDINANCE NO. 7

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR
THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the govern-
ing body of the City of Overbrook,
Kansas:

Section 1. That the regular city
election of the City of Overbrook,
Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday
the fifth day of April, 1949, from the
hours of 8 o'clock A. M., and to
6 o'clock P. M., in the Kansas State
Bank, for the purpose of electing a
Mayor, a Police Judge and five
Councilmen.

Section 2. That Delbert English,
Mrs. Irving Haas and L. D. Coffman
are hereby designated by the Mayor
with the approval of the Council
to act as Judges of said election, and
Mrs. Ethel Atchison and Mrs. Ed-
gar Finley are hereby designated by
the Council to act as Clerks of said
election.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take
effect and be in force from and
after its publication in The Over-
brook Citizen, the official City paper.
