

RESOLUTION NO. 11

WHEREAS, on December 18, 1980, the Mayor of the City of Overbrook, Kansas, caused to be published in the Citizen-Times, the official newspaper, notice that there would be a hearing by the Governing Body of the City of Overbrook, Kansas, on the 7th day of January 1981 at 7 o'clock p.m. to hear complaints with reference to the inclusion of the City in a proposed rural fire protection district as outlined in the notice and being more than twenty (20) days prior to the meeting, and

WHEREAS, at said meeting held on the 7th day of January 1981 no one appeared to protest the inclusion of the City within the proposed fire district and

WHEREAS, by authority granted to the City of Overbrook, Kansas, which is a city of the third class in K.S.A. 19-3605, the City may adopt a resolution directed to the Board of County Commissioners of Osage County, Kansas, to be included within the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERBROOK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the City of Overbrook, Kansas, petitions the Board of County Commissioners of Osage County, Kansas, to be included within and made a part of the proposed Fire District No. 4 of Osage County, Kansas, consisting of the territory included within the boundary lines of the fire district proposed by said Board, which fire district includes all of Elk Township and all of the City of Overbrook.

SECTION 2: That this resolution shall be presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Osage County, Kansas, and shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
