

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OVERBROOK TO LEVY AN ANNUAL TAX, NOT TO EXCEED ONE (1) MILL IN ADDITION TO THE PRESENT ONE (1) MILL, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING AND PROVIDING SUFFICIENT FUNDS TO OPERATE AND MAINTAIN SPECIFIC AREAS OF THE CITY UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OVERBROOK, KS.

WHEREAS, The Governing Body of the City of Overbrook has determined the need for additional funds to be used for operation and maintenance of specific areas of the City under the supervision of the Parks and Recreation Commission for the City of Overbrook, and;

WHEREAS, the levying of a tax, not to exceed one (1) mill in addition to the present one (1) mill, by the City, is permitted under K.S.A. 12-1908, Sec. (b);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Overbrook, Kansas;

SECTION 1: That pursuant to K.S.A. 12-1106, Sec.(b), the City of Overbrook is authorized to and shall make an annual tax levy of not to exceed one (1) mill in addition to the present one (1) mill upon all the taxable tangible property in the City of Overbrook, Kansas, for the purpose of creating and providing sufficient funds to operate and maintain specific areas of the City under the supervision of the parks and recreation commission.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall be published in the Osage County Chronical, the official paper of the City of Overbrook, one (1) time.

SECTION 3: Such annual levy shall be made unless a petition requesting an election upon the proposition of levying such tax, signed by not less than five percent (5) of the qualified electors of the City is filed with the County Election Officer within thirty (30) days following the date of the last publication of this resolution. In the event such petition is filed, no such annual levy shall be made without such proposition having been submitted to and having been approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon at the next primary or general election, or if such primary or general election does not take place within sixty (60) days after the date the petition is filed, at a special election called and held thereon.
