

RESOLUTION NO. 28

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERBROOK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The building inspector for the City of Overbrook, has filed with the Governing Body of the City, a statement in writing that the structure owned by Velma J.Vann, Route 1, Box 89, Carbondale, Kansas, situated on the following described real estate:

Beginning at a point 13 rods north of the corner-stone at the Southwest corner of the West 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 32, Township 14 South, Range 17 East of the 6th p.m., thence North 26 rods, thence East 13 rods, thence South 26 rods, thence West 13 rods to the place of beginning, lying within the city

limits of the City of Overbrook, Kansas,

is dangerous and unsafe and a health and fire hazard.

SECTION 2. The governing body hereby fixes April 8 1992 at 8:00 o'clock p.m. at the City Hall, Overbrook, Kansas, as the time and place at which the said owner, his or her agent, any lienholders of record and any occupant of such structure may appear and show cause why such structure should not be condemned and ordered repaired or demolished pursuant to K.S.A. 12-1752.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall be published once a week for two consecutive weeks on the same day of each week and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to mail a copy of this resolution by certified mail within three (3) days after the first publication to said owner, marked, "deliver to addressee only."
