WHEREAS, The City of Overbrook, Kansas, a municipal corporation, has heretofore granted The Kansas Power and Light Company, a Kansas corporation, a franchise to use the public streets, alleys, and thoroughfares in the said City for the purpose of supplying electricity to the City of Overbrook, Kansas, and the inhabitants thereof, being Ordinance No. 138, and

WHEREAS, the said Company is furnishing street lighting service in the City of Overbrook, Kansas, and it is the desire of the said City that certain changes and/or extensions be made in the existing street lighting system:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF Overbrook, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the City of Overbrook, Kansas, request and authorize The Kansas Power and Light Company to make the following changes and/or additions to the existing street lighting system in the said City:

Install one 175 watt (7,000 lumen) Mercury vapor street light on wood poles on corner of West 2nd Street where it ends.

Section 2. That the City of Overbrook, Kansas, pay The Kansas Power and Light Company for the street lighting service and installation charges resulting from the additions or changes described above at prices and terms and conditions set forth in the Company's rate schedule _____, now on file with the State Corporation Commission of Kansas, or as amended by authority of said Commission or other regulatory body having jurisdiction over the rates charged by Company. The prices applicable to the service covered by this resolution and named in said schedule are as follows:

For each 7,000 lumen (multiple) mercury vapor lamp on wooden pole with overhead conductor, \$64.20 per year.
