WHEREAS there are no revenue bond ordinances or other ordinances or resolutions of the municipality which require financial statements and financial reports to be prepared in conformity with K.S.A. 75-1120a(a) for the year ended 2002.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Overbrook, Kansas, in regular meeting duly assembled this 25th day of June, 2003 that the City Council requests the Director of Accounts and Reports to waive the requirements of K.S.A. 75-1120a(a) as they apply to the City of Overbrook for the year ended 2002.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of Overbrook, Kansas shall cause financial statements and financial reports of the City of Overbrook to be prepared on the basis of cash receipts and disbursements as adjusted to show compliance with the cash basis and budget laws of this State.
