

RESOLUTION NO. 58

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVERBROOK, KANSAS, STATING COMMITMENT TO SEEK FUNDING THROUGH THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, SMALL CITIES CDBG PROGRAM, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000 AND FURTHER COMMITMENT, BY THE CITY, TO LEVERAGE PROJECT COSTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000 WITH A KDHE STATE REVOLVING LOAN.

WHEREAS, Title 1 of the Housing and Community Act does state as its primary objective, "The development of viable urban communities, by providing decent housing and suitable living environment and expanding opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income."

WHEREAS, Title 1 does offer to communities the opportunity of monetary assistance in accomplishing its stated primary objective with a Community Development Block Grant; and,

WHEREAS, THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE is designated to award Community Development Block Grants under Title 1; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Overbrook, Kansas, does have areas of need, which may be addressed through the Community Development Block Grant Program.

WHEREAS, The City of Overbrook, Kansas, intends to submit a grant application for funding of a sewer system improvements project through the Community Development Block Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERBROOK, KANSAS:

1. The total project cost of the proposed project is \$600,000. The City intends to request a grant of \$300,000 through the CDBG Program. The remaining cost will be provided through local matching funds in the amount of \$300,000 with a KDHE state revolving loan.
2. The Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit documents, which are necessary in applying for funding and establishing an Administrative Organization to implement activities pursuant to the aforementioned act.
