

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERBROOK, KANSAS:

At a regular meeting of the City Council for the City of Overbrook, Kansas on December 14, 2005 on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the Council resolves to call an election to determine whether sale at retail of cereal malt beverage in the original package shall be allowed on any Sunday, except Easter, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 P.M.; and to determine whether the sale of alcoholic liquor in the original package shall be allowed on any Sunday, except Easter, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 P.M., and on Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day, within the city of Overbrook, Kansas.



