City Hall- Per our Water Distribution Project and Ordinance #415, the City of Overbrook Water and Sewer rates were to go up 2% on January 1, 2024. At the December 13, 2023 City Council Meeting, the Council reevaluated this increase and moved it to 5% for 2024 only. The Council felt this was necessary due to additional expenses related to the project along with the price increase of the RWD#5 contract. You will see this increase on the bill due February 20, 2024. The scheduled increase in 2025 remains at 2%. Please call City Hall if you have any questions. Thank you!

It's inexpensive and easy and helps us locate where an animal lives should they run off. Every effort is made to locate the owner of a loose animal, but if the owner cannot be located, the animal is transported to Carbondale Pet Clinic.

If you are in need of a trash container one can be purchased by calling Osage Waste at 785-836-9392, or you can purchase your own container from a store of your convenience.

Water Conservation in the home – In 2024 each month we will have a water conservation tip that might help reduce your water bill. This month's tip is for the laundry room. Use Clothes Washer for Only Full Loads. With clothes washers, avoid the permanent-press cycle, which uses an added 5 gallons (20 liters) for the extra rinse.
