As the Police department patrol we have noticed that there are several properties with appliances out in the yards, like washers and dryers, refrigerators and the like. Please make arrangements to remove these items as soon as possible. It not only looks bad, it's against city ordinance 353 and it's also very dangerous. Kids have been accidentally shut in some appliances like that and the end result more times than not is tragic. Trees are blooming and growing leaves which make the limbs hang lower to the ground. Tree limbs are to be no lower than 12 feet from the street. School buses and other larger trucks often hit these limbs, causing them to weaken and then fall to the street. And last but certainly not least, be careful when cleaning up brush piles, or just general cleaning of the yard. Snakes are coming out now, including copperheads and rattlesnakes. Watch where you reach, wear long pants, sturdy shoes or boots and gloves. Have a safe spring. Chief.
