Update on water project - As we begin 2023, we will be starting the year with a new water system for the entire city. 2022 brought many challenges for you and the City and we appreciate your understanding during the construction phase of the project. The warranty period will begin for project after we complete the USDA Rural development project requirements. Many of you have contacted the City with concerns about the project. We have logged these concerns and the contractor has addressed some of them and will be addressing the remaining concerns. We expect grass seeding and lawn repair to begin in the spring. Utility bills and meter readings –The Overbrook City Council voted at the December 2022 Council Meeting to apply \$5,000 worth of our ARPA Relief funds to the January 2023 City of Overbrook Utility Bills. With 455 active meters, that means each account will receive an \$11 credit. You will see a line item on your bill showing this credit. We would like to thank the community for being patient with us on your utility bills. We are learning the process and hope it will become smoother for you and for us in the future. Thank You!

Water Ordinance - Per Ordinance #415 a 9% rate increase on water and sewer rates will go in effect as of the January 2023 meter readings. Overbrook Police Department – In January, the Police Department will participate in the New Year's Taking Down DUI traffic enforcement campaign with the Kansas Highway Patrol. The enforcement campaign will last from December 26th through January 2nd and target impaired drivers, as well as other traffic offenses. 2023 Pet Tag information: Please contact City Hall 785-665-7328 to have your 2022 pet tag auto renewed for 2023. We'll need to have current rabies vaccination information on file. Once requested, we'll bill to your account and mail your tag to you. If you prefer to come into City Hall to get your tag, that is fine as well.
