Overbrook Police Department – Severe weather season will be here before we know it and here are some safety tips for everyone. When you hear the term Thunderstorm 'Watch' or Tornado 'Watch', this just simply means that weather conditions are favorable for severe weather. All you need to do is just keep an ear open for updates. Contrast this with the word 'Warning' which means severe weather or a tornado has either been indicated by radar or seen by trained storm spotters. If you remember last year, the tornado that hit southern Douglas County passed just south of Overbrook. This is NOT the time to go out onto your porch or yard to see the storm. It means take cover immediately. For those without a basement or storm cellar, when a warning seems imminent, we will have members from the Overbrook Fire Department or the Police Department at the Kansas State Bank. Another location to seek shelter is the Overbrook Bible Church on the West edge of town. Finally, remember that there is a **free informational talk** on Thursday, March 12 at 7:00pm at the Carbondale Community Center, 228 Main St. This talk has fantastic information presented by the National Weather Service and the Osage Co. Emergency Management team. You can also learn how to get critical updates and alerts when severe weather is in our area. See the attached flyer for more information. Have a safe and happy spring.
