**Update on water project** – <a href="https://overbrookks.com/water-distribution-project">https://overbrookks.com/water-distribution-project</a> The construction phase of the water project is reaching final completion. We recently started the new chlorination building which was the last major hurdle in the construction phase. There is a significant amount of cleanup, grading, and grass seeding to be completed. This process will be completed in the spring. Many of you have expressed concerns about this part of the process and we have provided a compiled list of items that need to be addressed during the final clean up phase to the contractor. We will be entering the 1-year warranty period of the project which will run into the spring of 2024. If you have concerns, we encourage you to report these during this period, so the contractor has an opportunity to address the issue. The new water system will serve the community for many years to come providing clean safety drinking water for the growth of Overbrook. We would like to thank you all for your patience during this project.

**Tree Dump** – Many people will be cleaning up their yards this month and we wanted to remind you of the guidelines for the city tree dump. Only tree limbs and leaves may be dumped at the site. No plastic bags, furniture, rocks, construction material or logs bigger than 18 inches. A key may be picked up at City Hall to unlock the gates to the dump.

**Historical Tidbit** - Did you know that Willard Cobb was the first Mayor of the City of Overbrook? He was first elected in July of 1948 and served through August of 1949. Before Cobb's election, Overbrook had never been able to form a local government due to its status as an unincorporated town. In fact, at one time Overbrook claimed (without the ability to substantiate the statement) that it was the largest unincorporated city in the United States.
