
# **Overbrook City News and Events** October 2020

**Deadline for Posting Addresses** – Address numbers must be posted on all buildings, not mailboxes, by Jan. 1, 2021. The numbers must be at least 3 inches tall and visible from the road to be in compliance with the city ordinance and to support our 911 system. Get yours done before the weather turns bad. Thank you for helping our town to be safe.

**Autumn Leaves & Branches** may be taken to the City Tree Dump located southeast of town on 165<sup>th</sup> Street. Just stop by City Hall and pick up a key as the tree dump is kept locked. All leaves must be loose and may not be left in plastic bags. Please do not leave large logs. The City Tree Dump is not for commercial use. Thank you for your patience as we work to make the gates easier to open.

**Recycling Bins** – Please remember that the blue recycling bin is for recycling only. Do not put trash in it as Osage Waste & Disposal will not pick it up. Thank you.

**Friend of the Library** – Due to lack of storage space, the Friends of the Library will NOT be able to accept donations at this time. We are asking all patrons to please keep saving their books at home and in July 2021 we will post dates for you to bring them to the community room for the sale. We apologize for this inconvenience and hope everyone will continue to support us with their donations next July.

**MedSafe** - MedSafe is a medication disposal system that is now available at the Overbrook Police Department or Overbrook City Hall. All you have to do is bring your unused or expired medication to us and we will safely dispose of it. This system accepts controlled, non-controlled and over-the-counter medicines. MedSafe meets the requirements of the DEA Controlled Substances Act.
